

GETTING A LIBRARY CARD

What do I need to get a library card?

Acceptable Identification

What is acceptable identification?

- Valid Driver's License
- Ohio State Identification
- Student Identification
- Car Registration
- Checkbook
- Current Utility Bill
- Military I.D.
- Passport

Are there age requirements or restrictions?

Yes.

You must be 18 years or older to sign for a card.
(You may borrow two books when you apply.)

What happens if I don't have acceptable identification?

The library will send you a post card that becomes acceptable identification once you return it to the library. You can not borrow any materials until the mailed post card is returned and a library card is received.

LIBRARY CARD FACTS

Cost...

1. First card is free.
2. You can use your library card in all Shelby County locations.
3. **There is no charge to renew your card.**
4. **Replacement cards cost \$1.00.**

Responsibilities. . .

1. You need to report any address or name change.
2. **You need to report a lost card immediately.**
3. **You will be responsible for all items checked out if a card has not been reported lost.**
4. Allowing friends and family members to check out items on your card means you are responsible for their overdues or charges.



Limitations. . .

1. **You may have 50 items checked out on your card at one time, with additional restrictions on digital media materials.**
2. You will not be able to check out any items if you have more than two overdues or owe \$5.00 in charges.
3. You must have your card with you to use the Internet, to check out digital media materials, to check out toys, or to check out more than two books.
4. You can check out two books only, if you are a registered borrower, your account has no blocks, and you visit the library without your card.

CHILD/TEEN CARD

What if I'm not old enough to get a card on my own?

You will need to have your parent or legal guardian sign for you. If they do not have acceptable identification, the library will mail home an application card to verify your address. Once your parent or legal guardian signs it and you return it to the library you will receive your own library card. **(You may borrow two books when you apply.)**



What am I allowed to borrow?

The library does not monitor or restrict selection by minors. You are free to borrow any material with the exception of videos. A parent or legal guardian must sign a release form in order for you to freely borrow videos or use the internet.



NOTE TO PARENTS:

If our policy of unmonitored selection by minors does not meet your approval, please register for your own card and monitor your child's selection by charging out materials on your own card.

INTERNET USAGE

We offer internet computers at all of our library locations! Just stop in with your card and we will assist you in getting started.

All libraries now have wireless access as well, so if you prefer, you may bring your laptop to use the internet.

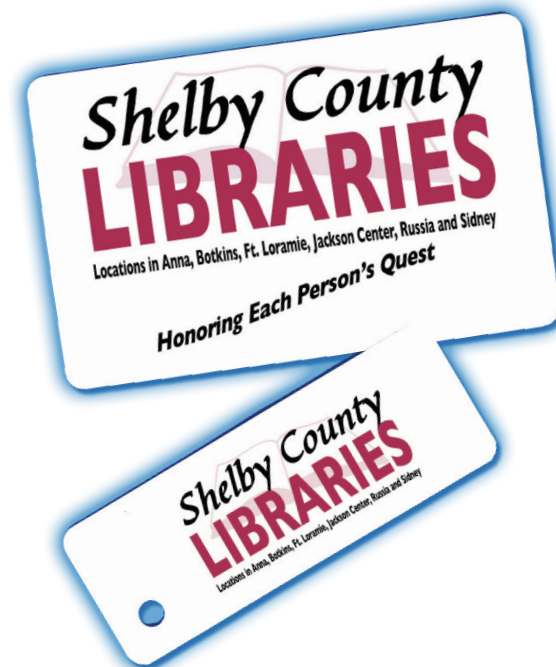
